## #1 Introduction to Playing with Paint

### WHAT TO EXPECT

Learn how to manipulate water and paints, to develop an intimate relationship with your watercolours to the point where you almost know what to expect before it happens, but most importantly become willing to accept and even welcome the unexpected.
